Information Sheet

About the Private training sessions

We recommend you take advantage of our private training package which includes 2 x 1hr private sessions. The fee is \$195 and must be paid prior to the start of your first session. Alternatively, you can book your first 1hr session as a "stand alone" session for \$145. Whichever you chose all subsequent sessions will be \$75 if you wish to continue private training. If you would like to go on and train in our regular Sunday group training classes with other dogs you will nearly always need a minimum of 2 private sessions unless your dog and yourself are quite experienced.

When and where

Private sessions are usually conducted at my premises at a time suitable to the owner and myself. These are booked online on my website. Should you require me to come to your home there will be an additional fee. Classes are held on Sunday mornings at the Pullenvale State School in the lower oval and commence somewhere between 7am and 8.30am depending on the time of year. Normally you will have at least two private sessions before commencing the classes but for some more experienced people that can be altered. If you have booked a private session but wish to change times you can do this online or contact me as long as there is a minimum of 24 hours notice; otherwise a \$10 re-booking fee will occur. I understand people and animals get sick but if you cancel at short notice I cannot refill the slot.

About the Private Sessions

Private sessions are held at my premises at 71 Layfield Rd Anstead. Please be aware that Google maps may send you across the road to my neighbour's place accidentally. Our premises is on the right hand side as you come down the road after turning off Mt Crosby Rd and we have a tall black chain mesh fence. Please come down the driveway and park on our property. **If you are arriving more than 5 minutes early, then please wait outside the gate instead as I may well have loose dogs out.**

There is a lot of information that I need to give you in your private sessions, particularly the first one. Sometimes it is hard to determine which bits of information are the most important so please let me know if you require any extra information or reading on any topic or activity or need me to more fully explain something. Particularly during the first lesson, I focus on teaching you about learning theory and how to train your dog by reinforcing the good behaviour, replacing unwanted behaviours and what the basic obedience cues are. If you have not emailed me verification of your dog's current vaccination status then please ensure that you bring this to your first session or you will be unable to train.

About the Group Training Classes

If you have completed two private sessions and we feel that you and your dog will go well in group classes, you will be able to book for these online pay as you go. (\$15 per class).

Classes are usually held at Pullenvale state school but at present are being held at our Anstead premises due to new turf being laid at the school. Please park in the lower car park of the school on Grandview Rd Pullenvale and record your attendance in the book. Water is provided at class and there is a communal water bowl. Please feel free to bring your own if you prefer. From time to time I need to cancel classes eg due to rain or school functions being on. This is always advertised on my Facebook page so please visit before coming to class each week and if you 'like' the page you should be able to get email notifications. I endeavour to keep an email list of current clients and send emails too but sometimes this is hard to do.

What to bring to all sessions and classes.

- 🐾 Your dog's vaccination certificate even if you have already emailed a photo (first session only).
- 🐾 A doggie with a good appetite. Please ensure you do not feed your dog (unless a young puppy) before training. You will need sturdy walking type shoes and preferably waterproof if the weather is wet.
- 🐾 Bring any training equipment you have purchased previously to your first private session. You may be advised to purchase additional equipment and I strongly encourage you to use "long lines", more about this during your first private session.
- 🐾 If you have a treat pouch or a bum bag please bring one. If not, try and wear something with big loose pockets so you can dispense treats easily. Otherwise, I have a couple of types of treat pouches I can sell you.
- 🐾 Please bring treats with you and ensure that you have had your dog 'taste test' them before coming. Also bring some of your regular dog food.
- 🐾 You will need a hat, sunblock and water for yourself.
- 🐾 We have a small dam on the property at Anstead which dogs often drink from and swim in if they are allowed. You may wish to bring a towel
- 🐾 If you bring children under the age of 10 you will need a second adult for supervision

Important Rules - Facilities and use of the grounds.

We are lucky to have the use of the school grounds for training. Please ensure that your dog is always on lead unless directed otherwise. DO NOT approach other dogs without permission from the owner and also initially from staff of The Bounding Hound. Unlike other training schools, I do allow quite a lot of dog-to-dog interaction. For this to work, and in order to reduce the likelihood of negative encounters, it is important that everyone is familiar with the needs of other class members and their dogs before interactions occur. If you bring children remember that it is unfair to expect all dogs to be kid savvy, so ensure that you don't allow them (or adults including yourself) to pat or interact with other peoples' dogs unless staff have approved it. Remember too, that dogs can be unpredictable and dogs come from different backgrounds, not all dogs deal with new people or other dogs easily.

If you arrive late for classes, please be considerate to those in sessions. A first aid kit is held at the front of the school oval where the sign on sheet is.
